

## Prescription and Non-Prescription Medication Administration

9502.0435 subp. 16 F (1) The provider shall obtain written permission from the child's parent prior to administering prescription and non-prescription medicines, diapering products, sunscreen lotions, and insect repellents. Non-prescription medicines, diapering products, sunscreen lotions, and insect repellents must be administered according to the manufacturer's instructions unless there are written instructions for their use provided by a licensed physician or dentist.

The provider shall obtain and follow written instructions from a licensed physician or dentist prior to administering each prescription medicine. Medicine with the child's name and current prescription information on the label constitutes instructions.
